# Botany Grasses Activity - Object Tray

#### Materials:

# A tray containing:

- $\rightarrow$  (1) small container of rice
- $\rightarrow$  (1) small container of wheat
- $\rightarrow$  (1) small container of barley
- $\rightarrow$  (1) small container of oats
- $\rightarrow$  (1) small container of corn
- → Labels (see preparation below)

#### Preparation:

- 1. The teacher needs to take a tray and make a label that says "grasses" using masking tape and a permanent pen. Stick this label at the bottom of the tray's top surface.
- 2. The teacher needs to make a label for each of the small containers. Attach the labels to one of the sides of the container where it can be seen easily.
- 3. The **Grasses** tray is ready for presentation.

#### **Presentation:**

- 1. Invite the children to join you for a circle presentation.
- 2. The teacher should sit down with the children with the **Grasses** tray.
- 3. Explain to the children that you have something special that you want to share with them today.
- 4. The teacher should then place the **Grasses** tray directly in front of her.
- 5. Say, "This is the **Grasses** tray." Point to the label on the tray and read, "grasses".

- 6. Now say to the children, "Grasses are plants. Plants are living things. The teacher should say, "All living things have 4 things in common; food, air, water and they reproduce."
- 7. Every container on this tray is used to study grasses.
- 8. The teacher should say "Grasses" as she points to the label on the tray.
- 9. The teacher picks up a container on the tray and points to the label and says, "This label says \_\_\_\_\_\_(name of grass). \_\_\_\_\_ is a grass and grass is a plant."
- 10. The teacher should place the container in front of her and dip her fingers inside the container and feel the \_\_\_\_\_ (name of grass).
- 11. After the teacher has slowly felt the \_\_\_\_\_\_, she starts to pass the container around the circle by giving it to the child on her right saying, "\_\_\_\_\_ is a **grass** and grass is a plant."
- 12. Point to the label again and read, "\_\_\_\_\_\_".
- 13. Pick up each of the containers and repeat the process.
- 14. Return the containers to the tray.
- 15. Return the **Grasses** tray to where it belongs on the shelf.

### Variations and Extensions:

- 1. Change out the containers for other examples of grasses.
- 2. Study each type of grass separately.
- 3. Provide a product made from each grass to be experienced in a concrete way.

## Points of Interest:

- 1. There are many different grasses to study.
- 2. We eat many grasses.
- 3. Grasses are not always green!

# **Control of Error:**

1. The teacher has set up the tray correctly

## Aims:

To be introduced to **Grasses** as a type of plant in an concrete way.

# <u>Age:</u>

2 ½ and up

## Language:

Grasses, plants, names of grasses, etc.
