
Parts of a Fruit



Fruit is the ripened ovary of a flowering plant, containing one or more seeds. It may be dry, as in the poppy, or fleshy, as in the peach.



Mesocarp is the succulent and fleshy middle layer of the fruit, it is usually the part of the fruit that is eaten.
